Cigar Mold Corona I (Art. N° 33638)

Professional cigar mold from beech and spruce wood for 10 Double Corona Cigars.

Cigar measures: 7 1/2" \times 49

(200 mm length, Ø 19,6 mm)

Press measures: $14 \times 7.9 \times 2.3$ inches

 $(35,5 \times 20 \times 5,8 \text{ cm})$

The cigar mold itself and the bolts for high fitting accuracy of lower and top part are made from durable beech hard wood. The inner surface of the top part is lacquered to increase resistance. The top part consists of 15 routed and glued components and the bolts. The cigar molds are open at the front of the press to cut the cigars precisely.



Place the cigar bunch into the wooden mold

You need the mold to get proper cigars shapes. First the folded, uncut leaves are placed onto a leaf called the binder and rolled to form the approximate Corona size of the cigar, so you get the bunches. Place each bunch into lower part of the wooden mold, close the mold with the top part carefully and press them together with screw clamps or weights.





Turn the pressed bunches

Open the mold after 1 hour and turn the bunches a quarter (90°) to avoid uneven edges. Close it once again for 30-60 minutes as described. If there are edges after that, you may repeat turning.

Maintenance

Clean tobacco leavings with a soft brush or with a dry kerchief. Please handle the wooden molds carefully to avoid damages. Do never close the mold forcibly because you can damage the fine wooden edges especially of the top part.

Please handle the press carefully to avoid damage at the fine edges!
